Narrative: On Friday morning, April 27, 2007 a Mesa Verde National Park employee was injured at approximately 1015 hours (10:15AM) while diagnosing the mechanical operation a terra torch. The terra torch was staged and preparing for a prescribed fire on the Moab District of the Manti-La Sal National Forest. The injury was to the victim's right ring finger and resulted in a distal digit amputation to his right ring finger and causing tendon damage in another finger. The employee was stabilized by qualified emergency medical personnel and transported to the local hospital.
