SUMMARY

On the afternoon on July 12, 2016, resources were dispatched to the Pacheco Incident, a vegetation fire in Calaveras County. While attempting to suppress fire on the left flank, a CAL FIRE Type 3 fire engine was overrun by fire.

There were no injuries suffered in the incident. The engine sustained moderate damage from heat and flame impacts.
