**Incident Description:** Nearly a dozen hours after the (600) acre grass firefight had begun; Firefighter Adams collapsed and stopped breathing at approximately 2200hrs while he was backing his fire apparatus along the side of Hwy 51. Adams was assisted by other responders but succumbed to his injury and was pronounced at the scene.

Authorities suspect the fire was intentional because three fires were set within a mile of each other, just moments apart.
