NARRATIVE: I was contacted by Great Dismal Swamp NWR Refuge Manager Chris Lowie at 6:45 PM on 3/3/13 concerning a wildfire on Mackay Island NWR that occurred earlier in the afternoon. Chris provided me the contact information for the NC Forest Service, who were aware of the details. NC Forest Service District Forester Mike Petruncio provided the following information:

The wildfire was 15-16 acres in size with 15 acres burning on the refuge. The Knotts Island Volunteer Fire Department (VFD) responded. While fighting the fire, the Knotts Island VFD fire chief experienced a medical emergency. He was transported to the hospital and was pronounced dead on arrival. The

Virginia Beach Fire Department completed extinguishing the fire. The cause of the fire is currently under investigation by the NC Forest Service Law Enforcement Division.
