Narrative: On July 8, the acting Engine Captain of Engine 312 was conducting a physical training conditioning hike with several crew members when he became ill and collapsed. Immediate life-saving efforts were initiated and patient was air lifted to Crescent City, CA for aerial transport to Redding, CA but he could not be revived and was pronounced deceased.

A Facilitated Learning Analysis (FLA) Team has been formed to review the circumstances of the incident to learn individually, collectively and as an organization in order to facilitate accident prevention.
