Narrative: On 9/5/04 at approximately 1230 hrs. resources from CDF, USFS, and Amador County Fire Protection District responded to the Powerhouse Incident. The Eldorado Hotshots were assigned to construct fire line on Division Z (right flank). Line was being constructed from the River road uphill toward the top of the ridge on steep slopes ranging from 40-70% in a mature timber stand. At approximately 1706 hrs. a tree limb out of a green, 90' tall, 72"DBH California Live Oak, within the fires perimeter, broke off and fell striking a crewmember who was on the fire line, 38' away from the tree. The crewmember was struck on the back of the hard hat, and on his back. The crewmember was working as a swamper with a saw team. The crew had constructed approximately 1800' of line before the accident occurred. The crewmember was airlifted at approximately 1804hrs, and flown to Sutter Roseville Hospital for treatment. CDF is taking the lead in the investigation in cooperation with the US Forest Service. Preliminary findings indicate that all safety protocols were being followed.
