

Incident Name: Badger Canyon Fire Ash Pit Burn (2020)

State: Washington

Incident Type: Burn Injury

Description of the Incident:

A firefighter from the Umatilla National Forest Engine Module stepped into a hot ash pit during mop-up on the Badger Canyon Fire. The firefighter sustained 1st and 2nd degree burns (less than 2 percent of body area) to the leg above the boot. The patient was evaluated and treated on scene by U.S. Forest Service EMTs, then transported via ambulance to a hospital where he was treated and released. The patient was assigned one week of light duty. The home unit is conducting an AAR.
