Description of the Incident:

While working on the Red Salmon Fire on the Six Rivers National Forest, a firefighter from the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest was stung by a bee and experienced localized swelling on the arm. The patient was assessed on the fireline by U.S. Forest Service EMTs. Due to anaphylaxis concerns, the patient was evacuated by air. Upon arrival to the ER, the patient was stable and ambulatory and was subsequently released.
