Location: Tokewanna Fire, near Mountain View, WY

Date of Occurrence: July 29, 2016

Time of Occurrence: Approximately 1615 Hrs MDT

Activity: Wildland Fire Suppression

Narrative:

On the afternoon of July 29, 2016, a fire crew member from the Great Basin Smokejumpers was injured while scouting fireline on the Tokewanna Fire. Burn injuries were sustained to the hands, thighs, ears, nose and cheeks. The firefighter was transported by air ambulance to the Salt Lake Burn Center and admitted. The injured firefighter continues to work with the Salt Lake City Burn Center medical team to determine priorities for treatment while staying at a nearby lodging facility.

After consulting the BLM-WY Fire and Aviation Staff and BLM State Safety Officer, this incident is being deemed a "Wildland Fire Accident" as defined by the Interagency Standards for Fire and Fire Aviation Operations (the Red Book) Chapter 18.

An Accident Investigation Team from outside the High Desert District is assembled and conducting interviews to identify root causes and learn from the events leading up to the accident to prevent future occurrences.
